DGIS & Performance Measures

- Slightly updated DGIS forms roll out this month

- Any DGIS report created **on or after May 4th** will contain the updated forms
- Additional changes to come in FY 2024

Login.gov & Multi-factor Authentication

- Increased security for accessing Electronic Handbooks (EHBs)
- All grantee users will have to establish their credentials in login.gov
- Planned rollout: **May 26, 2023**

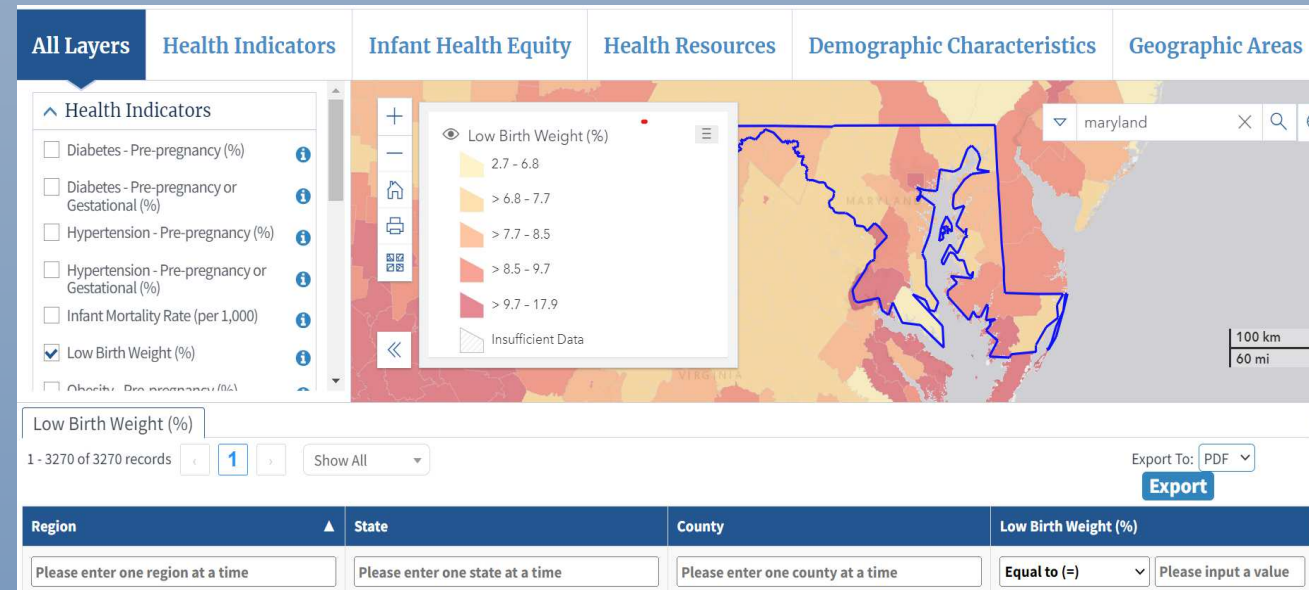

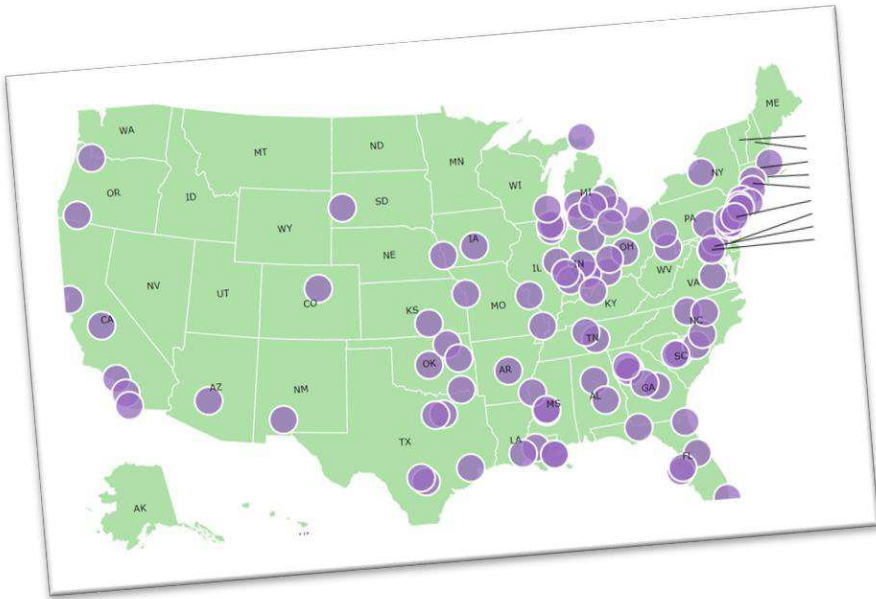

- HSMED data analysis
- Qualitative analyses of progress reports

Upcoming

- Recruiting up to 9 grantees to provide additional data
- Implementing web-based program survey
- Conducting Case Studies with 15 grantees:
 - Web-based network survey of CAN partners
 - Semi-structured interviews with program staff
 - Web-based survey for program participants
 - Learning site visits

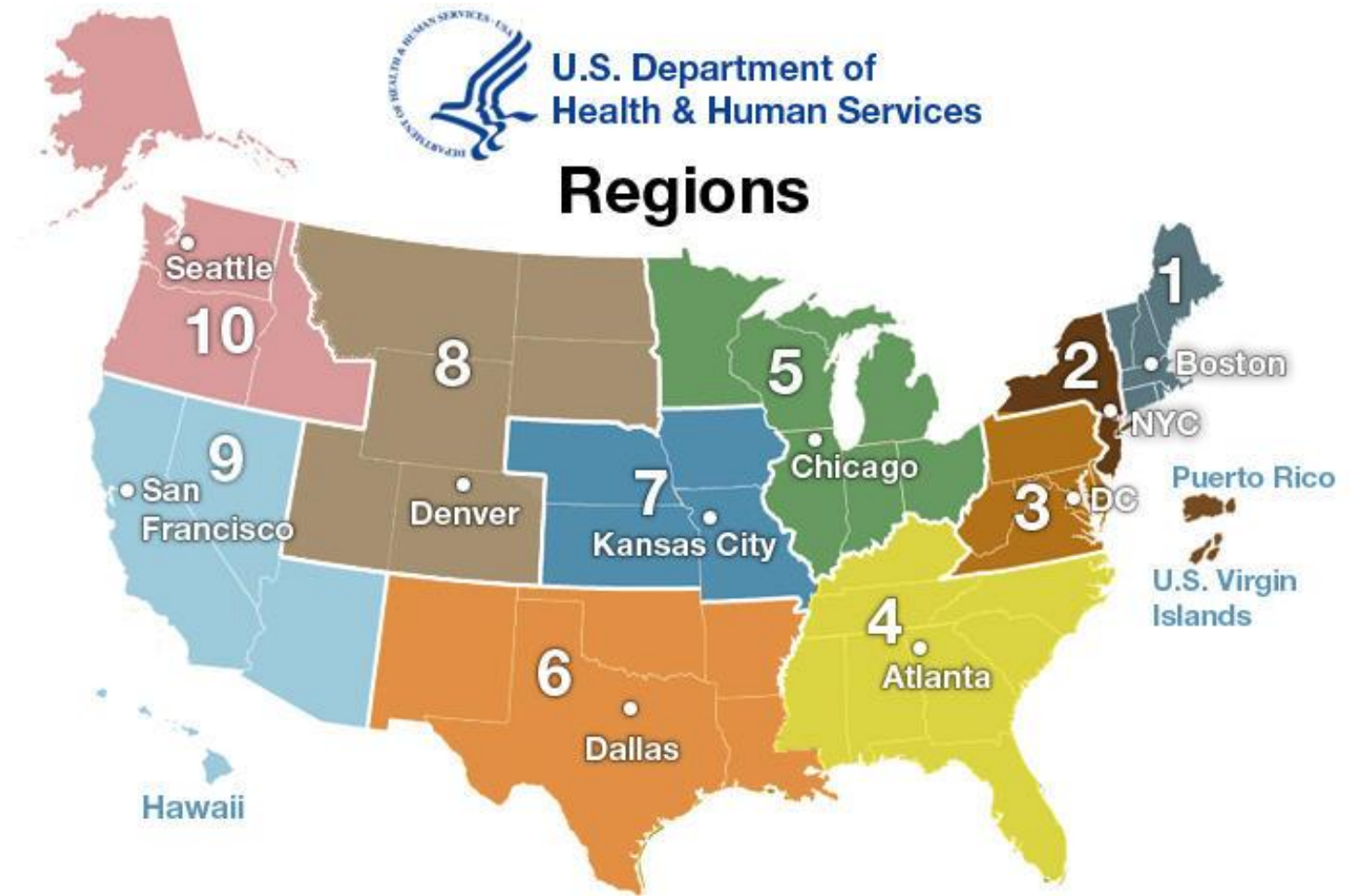

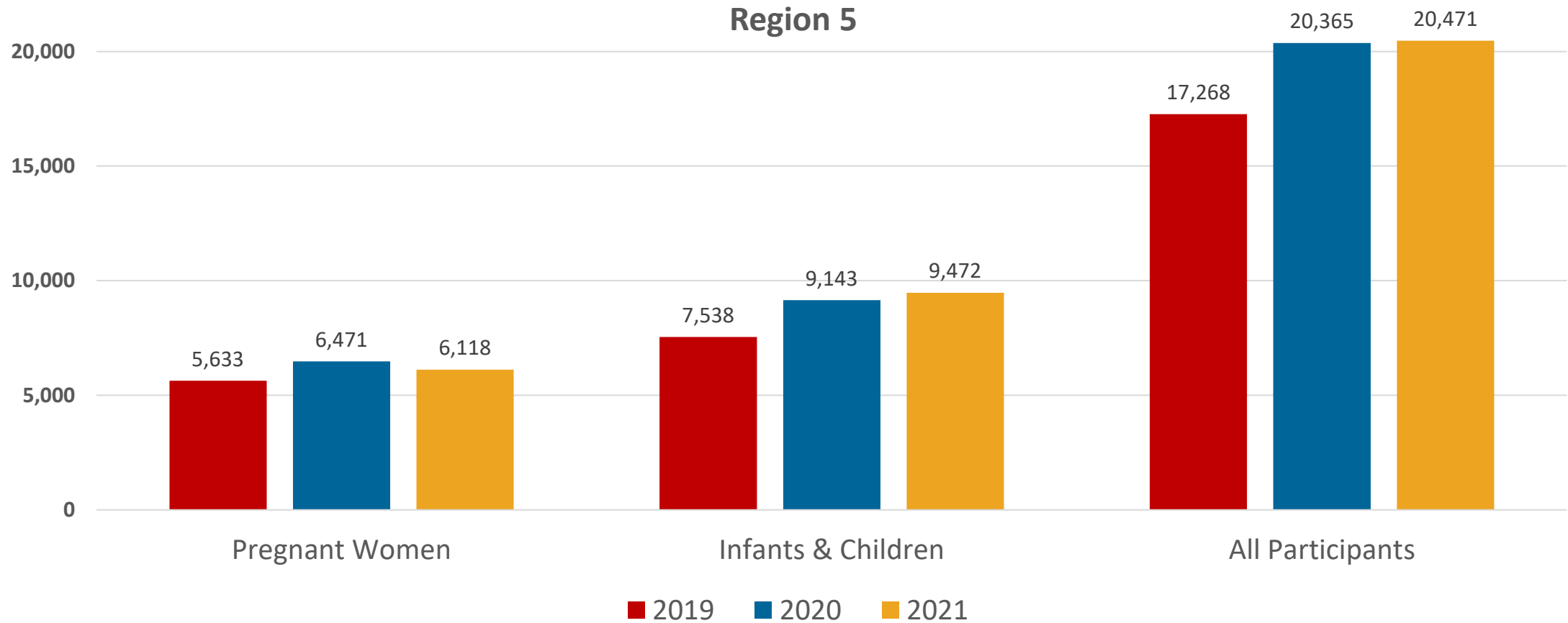

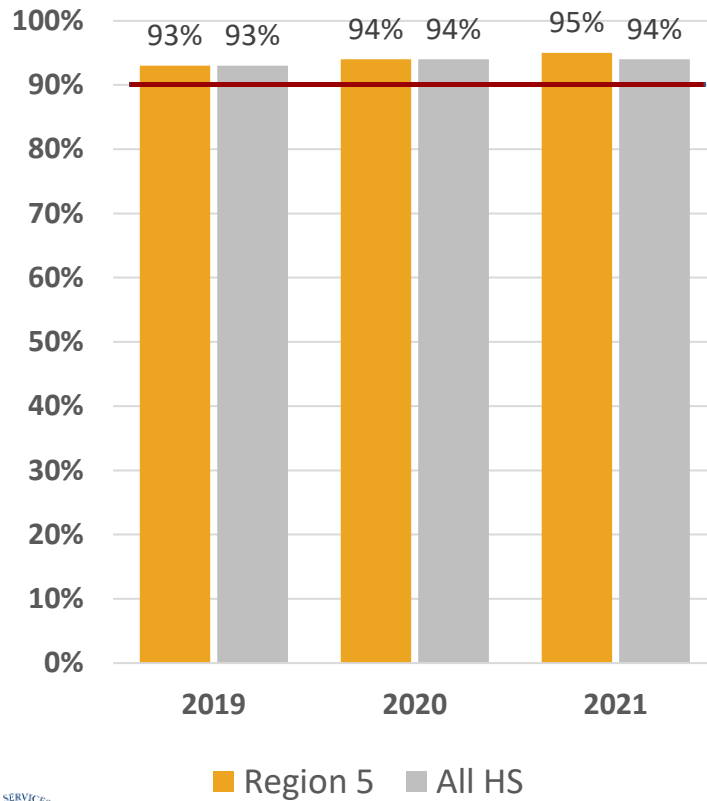


of Participants Served by Year (2019-2021)

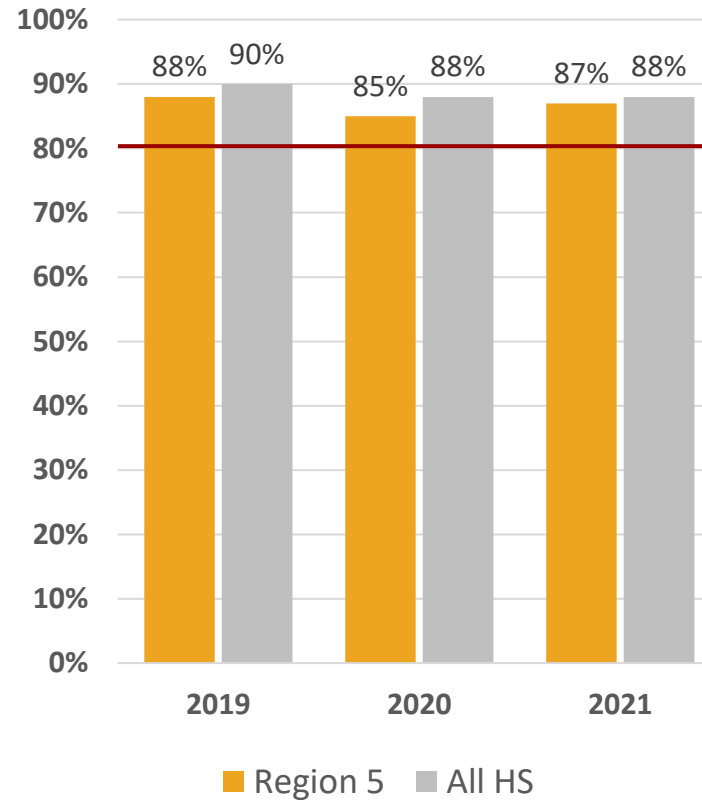


Health Care Access Trends (2019-2021)

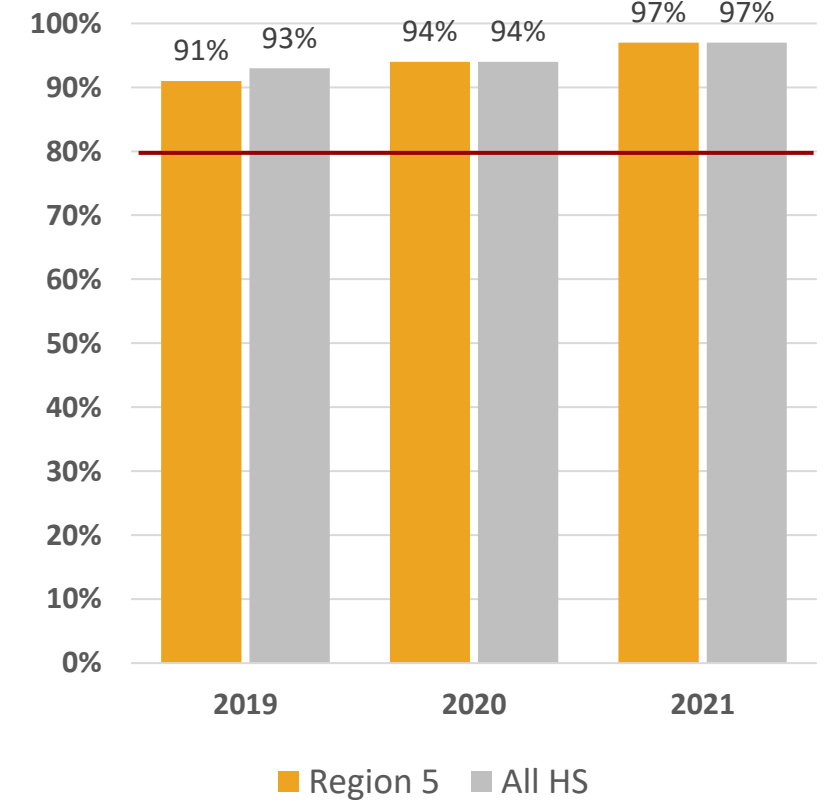

Usual Source of Care - ♀

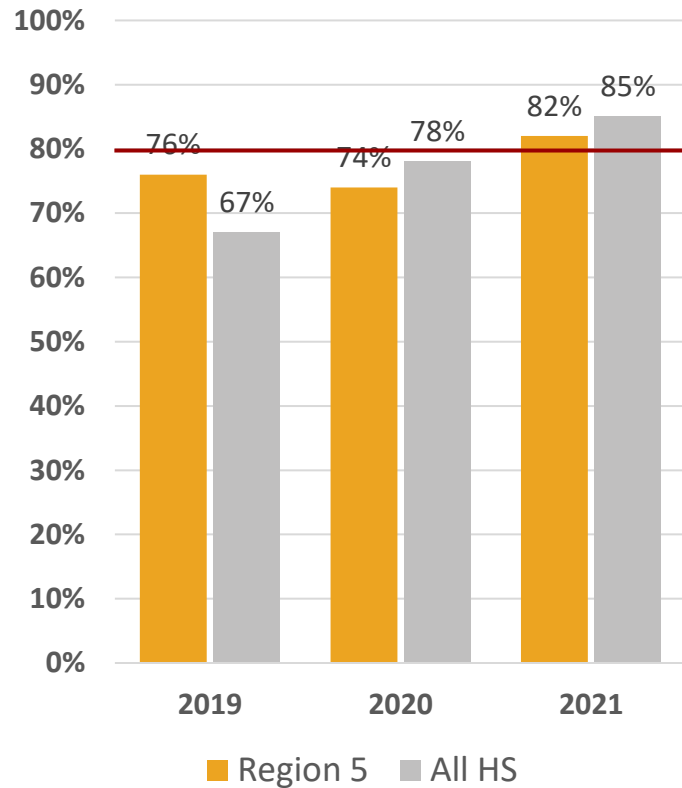


Usual Source of Care - Child

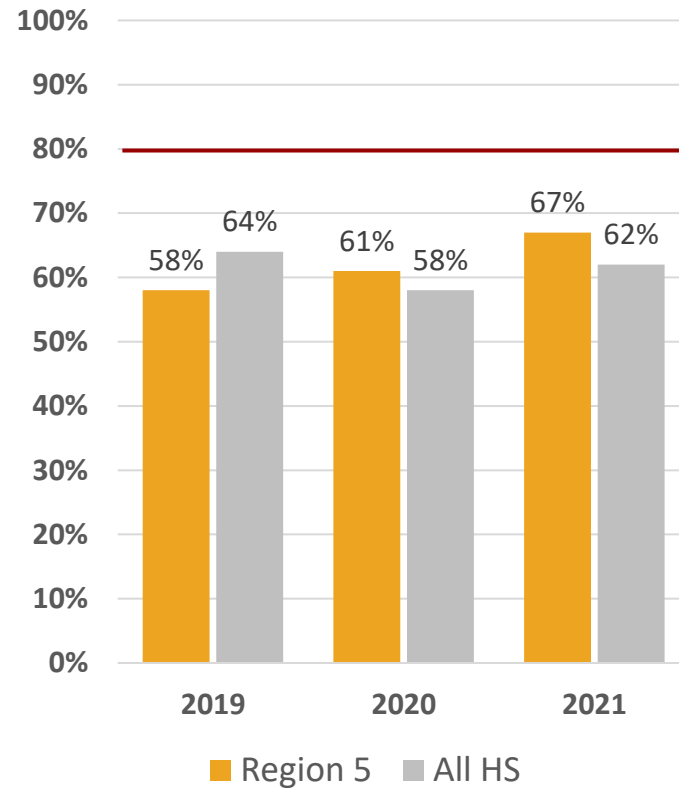


Women's Health Care Utilization Trends (2019-2021)

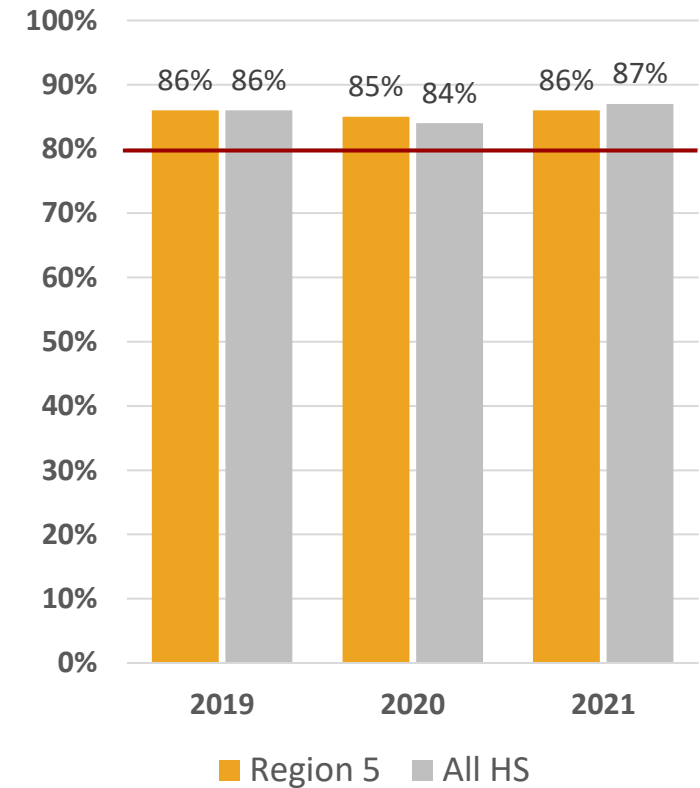
Prenatal Care - 1st Trimester



Postpartum Visit

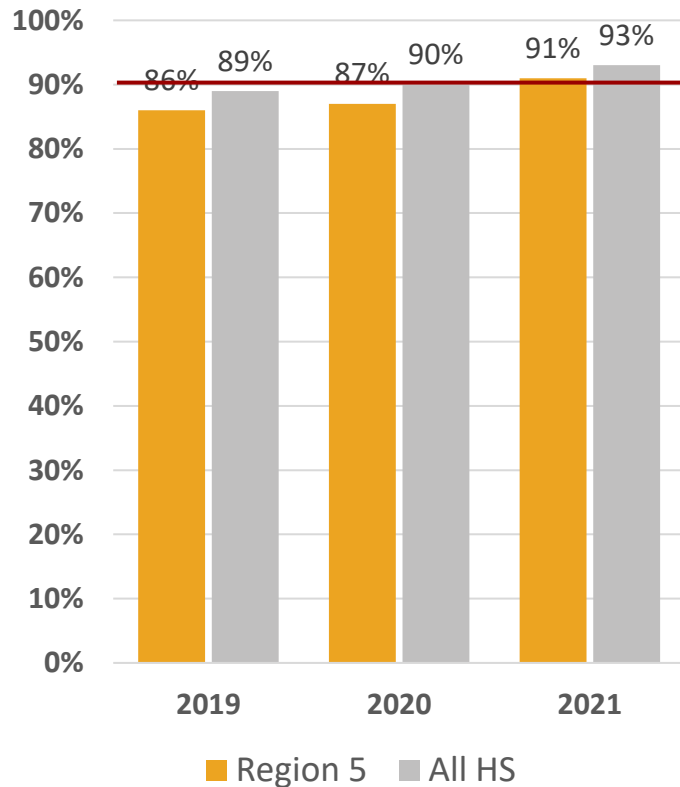


Well-woman Visit

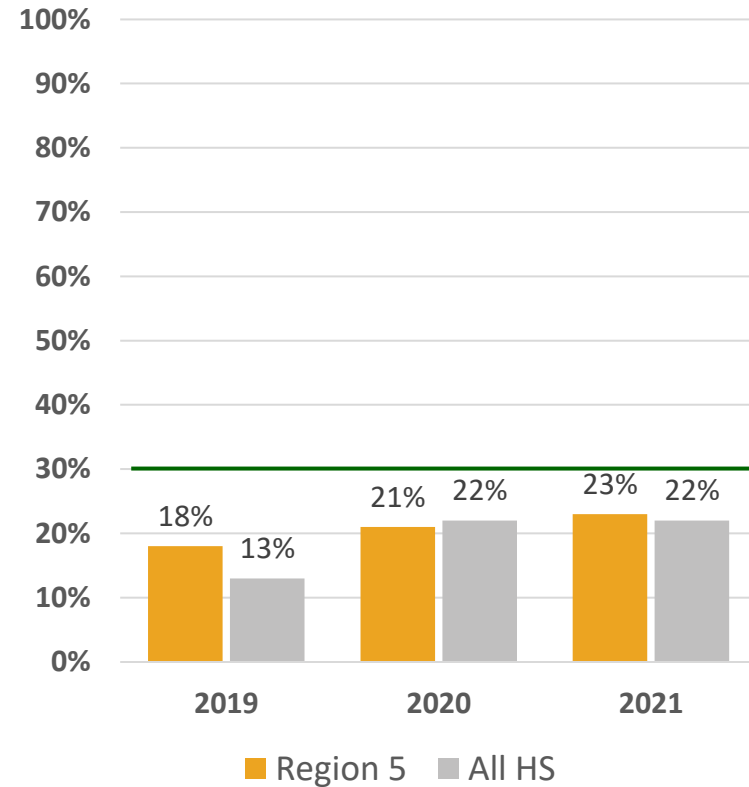

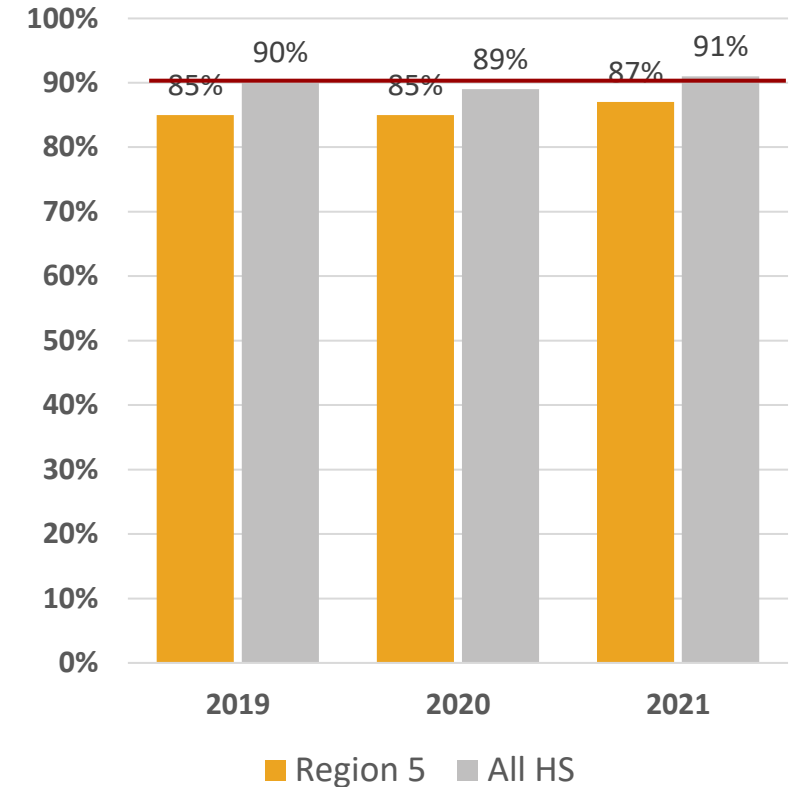

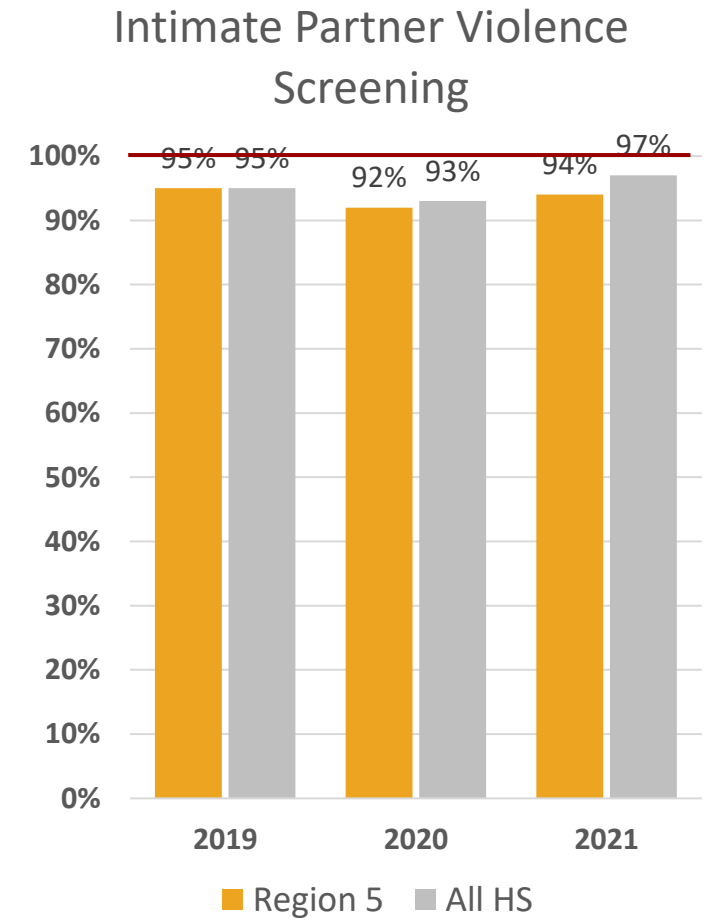
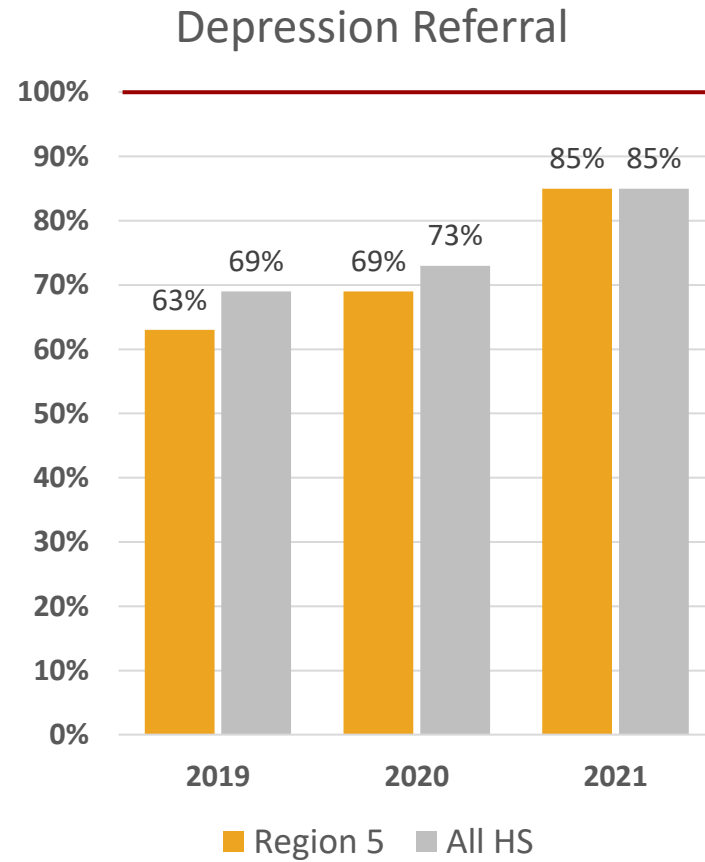
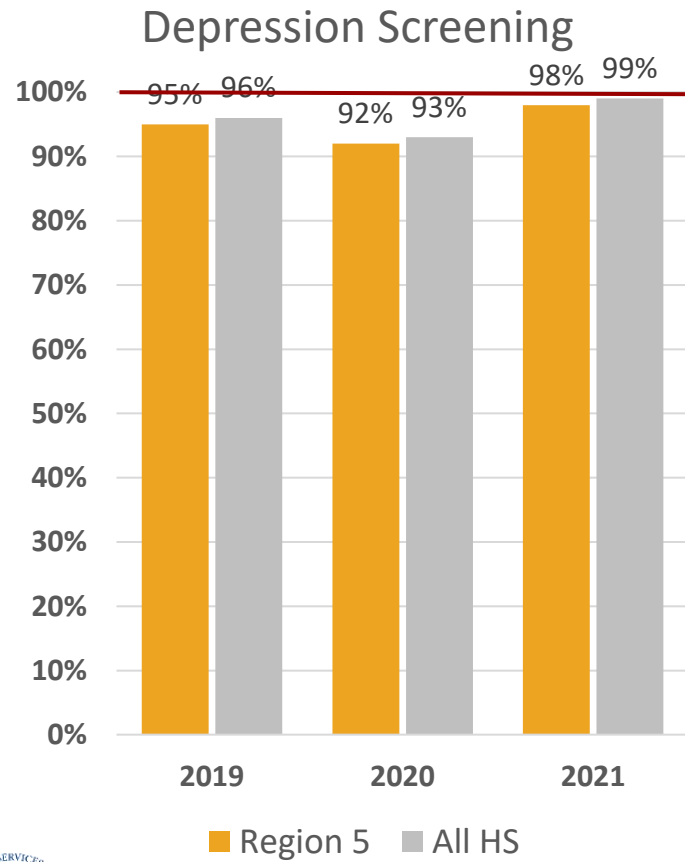
Interconception Spacing (↓)



No Tobacco Use in 3rd Trimester

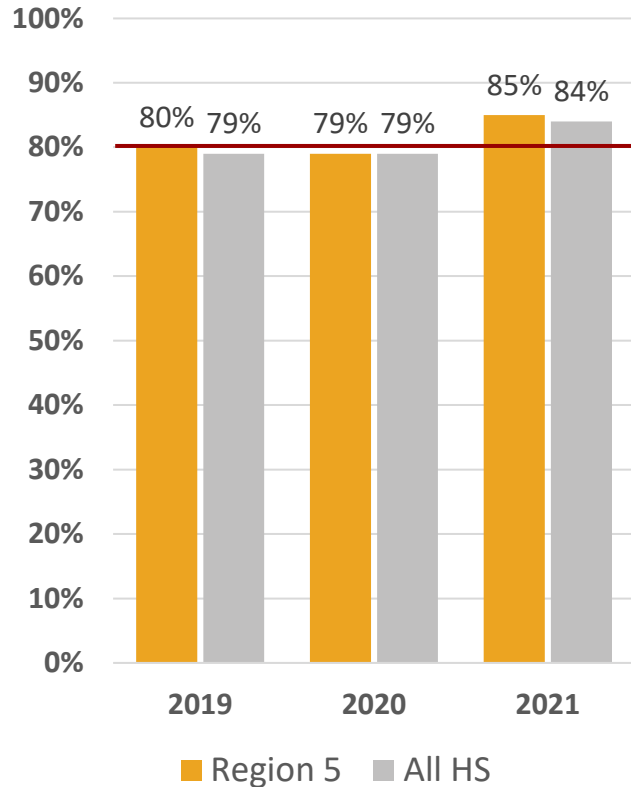


Personal Well-Being Trends (2019-2021)

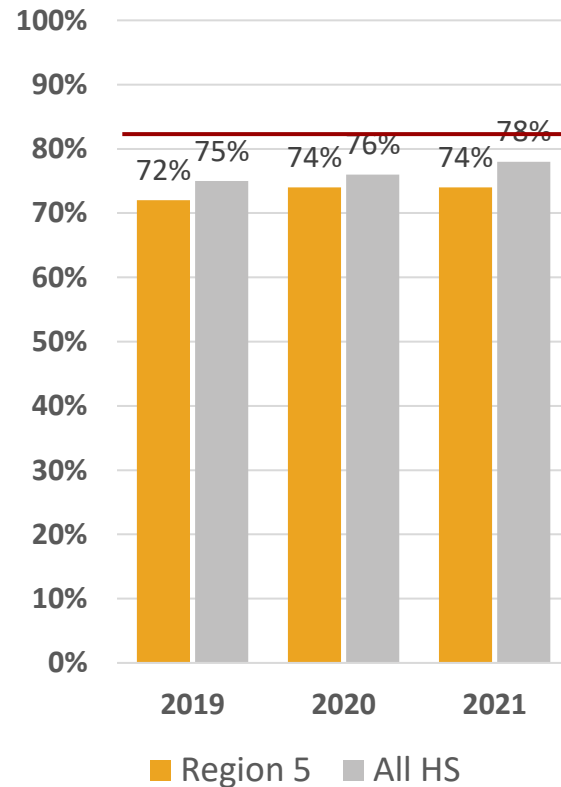


Care of Infant/Child Trends (2019-2021)

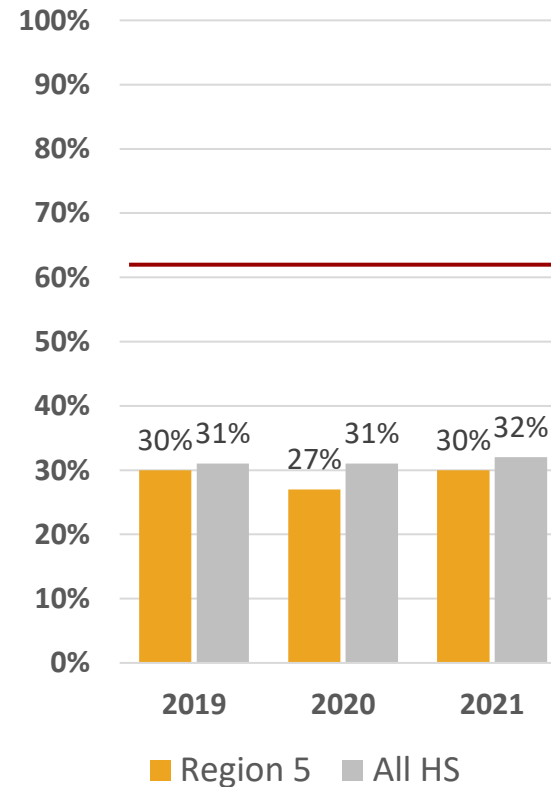

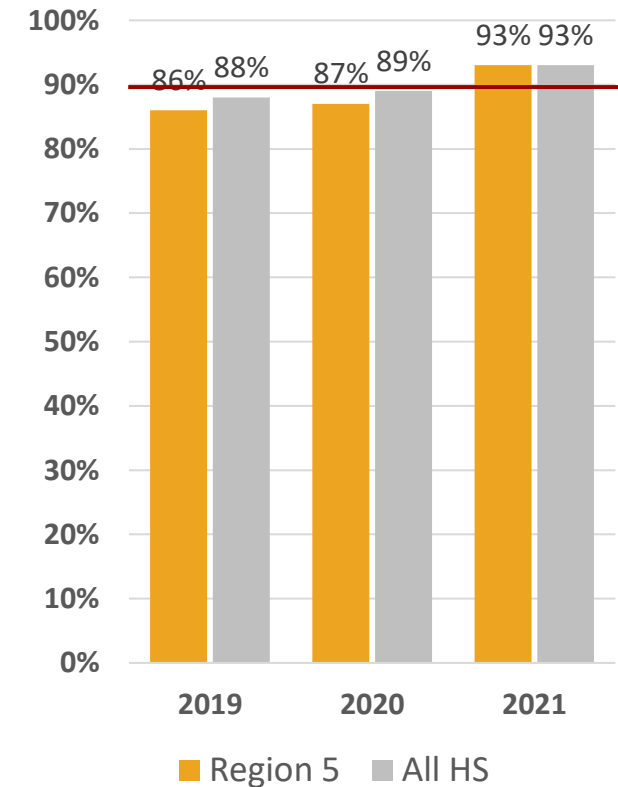
Breastfeeding - Ever

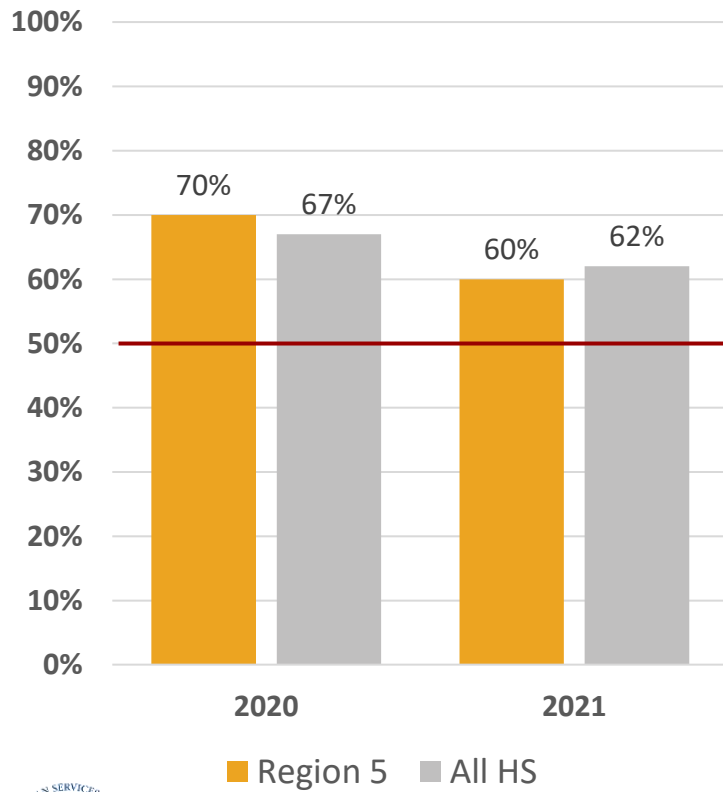

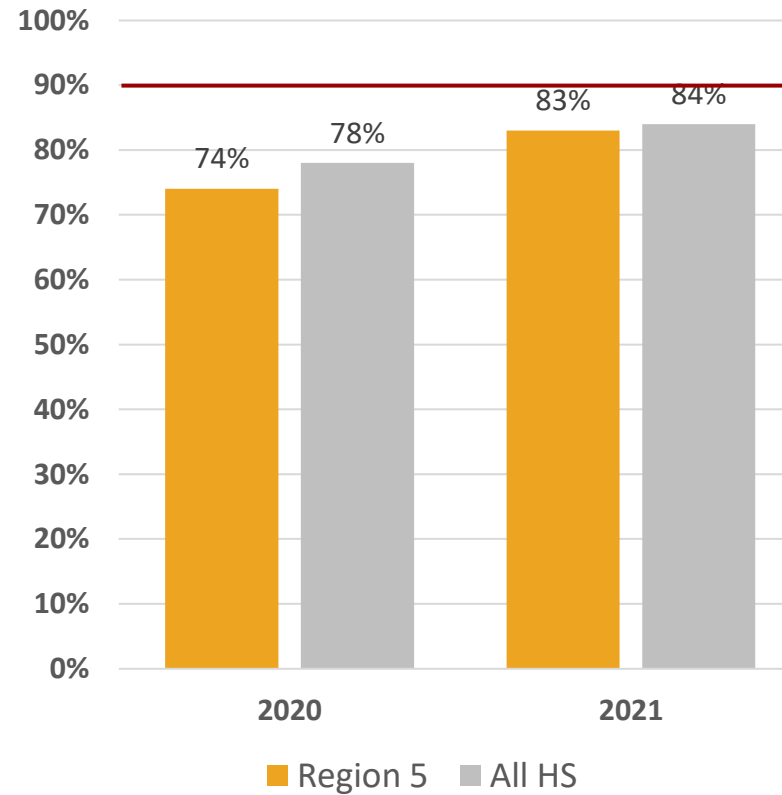

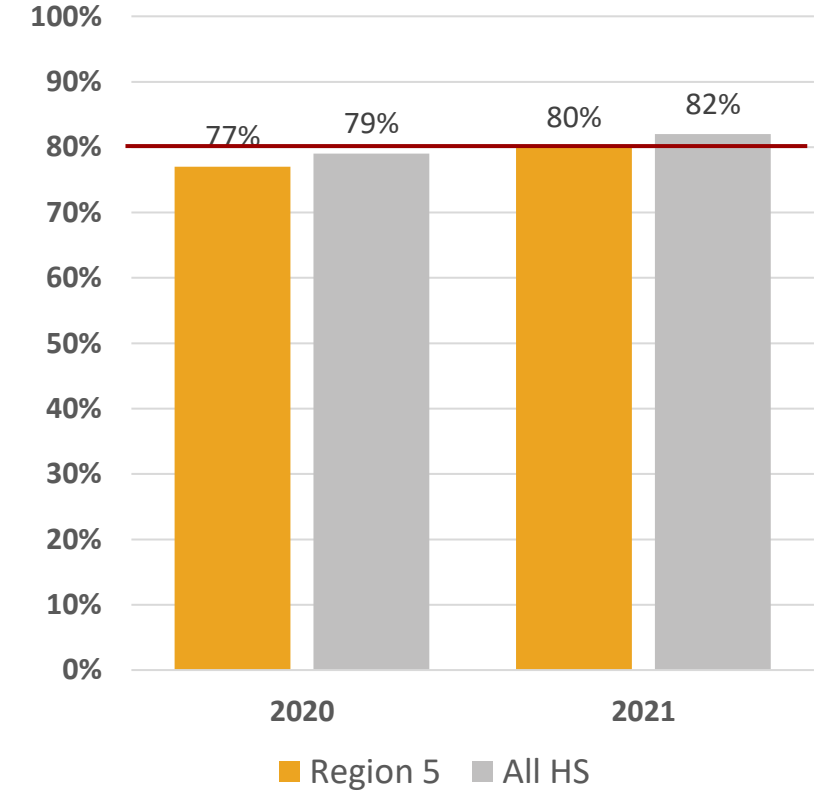

Father/Partner Involvement During Pregnancy

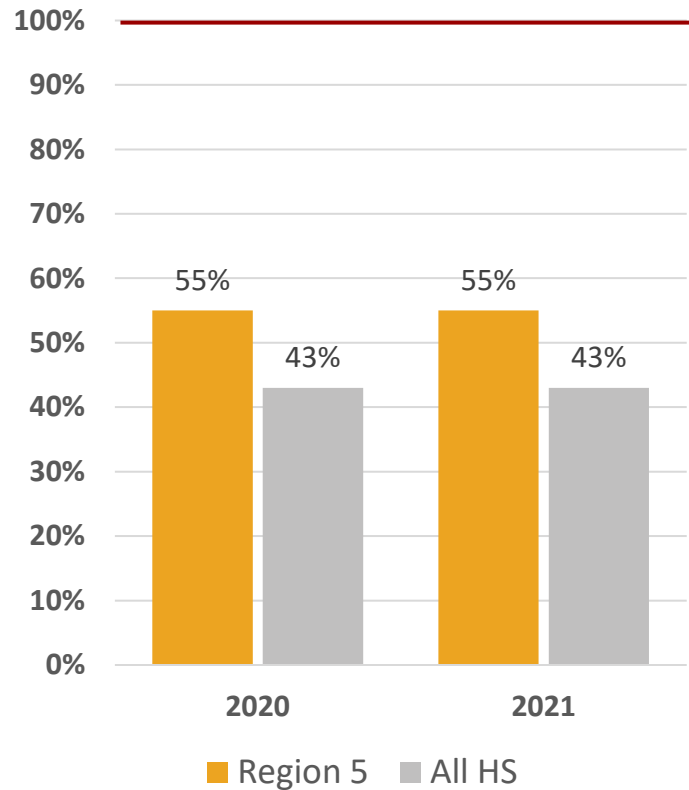


Father/Partner Involvement with Child <24mo

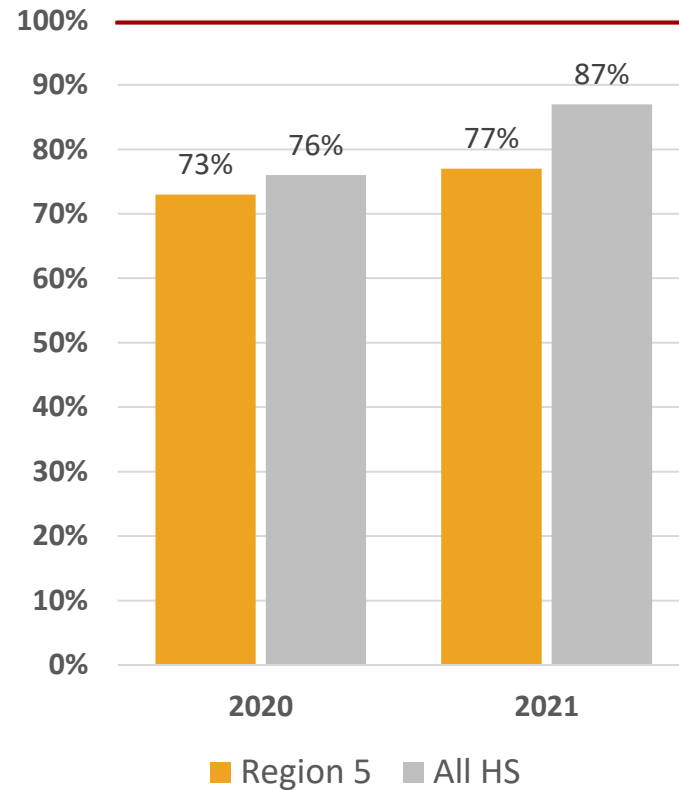

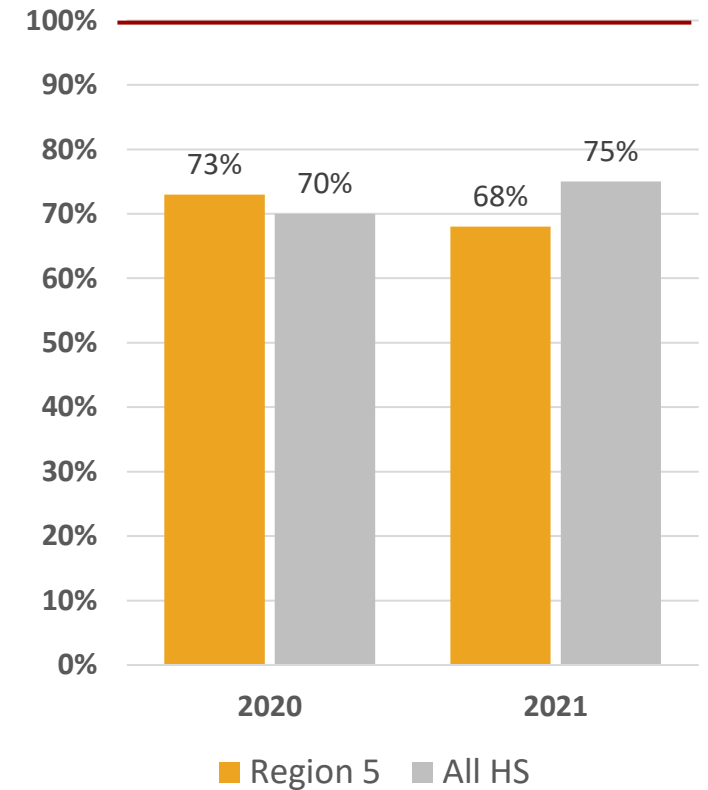

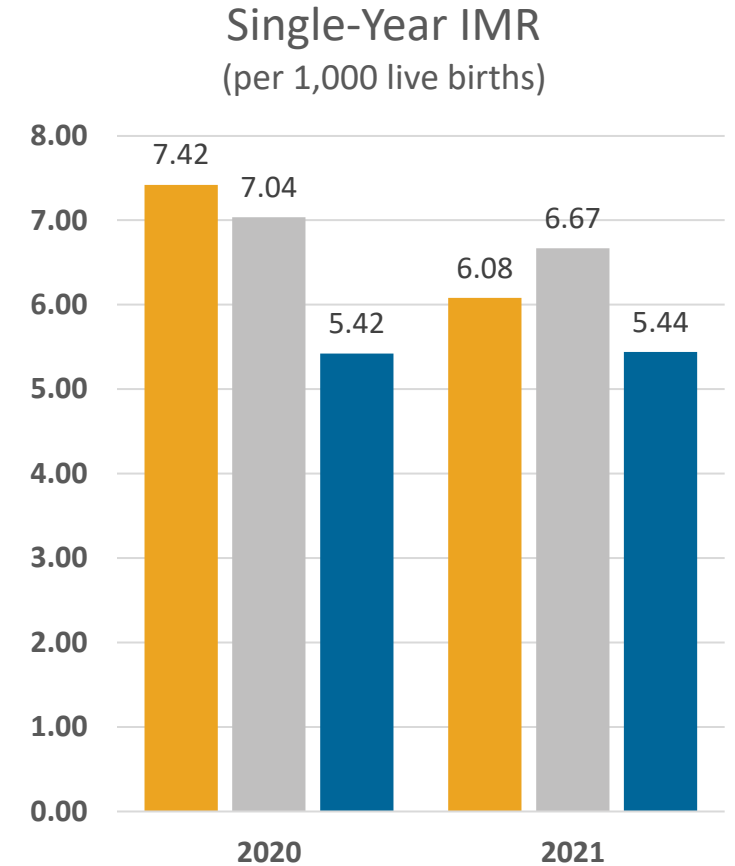
