Healthy Relationship and Marriage Education (HMRE)

- Authorized since 2006
- \$75M/annum in grants and contracts
- 8 legislatively allowed activities to promote healthy marriage/relationships
- Two current programs: Family, Relationship, and Marriage Education Works (FRAMEWorks); and Relationships, Education, Advancement, and Development for Youth for Life (READY4Life)


Responsible Fatherhood (RF)

- Authorized since 2006
- \$75M/annum in grants and contracts
- 3 legislatively required service areas:
 - Responsible parenting
 - Healthy marriage and relationships
 - Economic stability
- Current program: Fatherhood Family-focused, Interconnected, Resilient, and Essential (Fatherhood FIRE)
