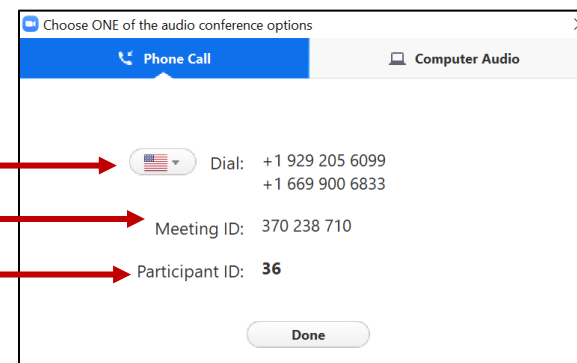
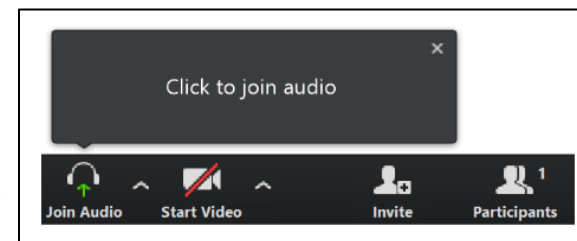

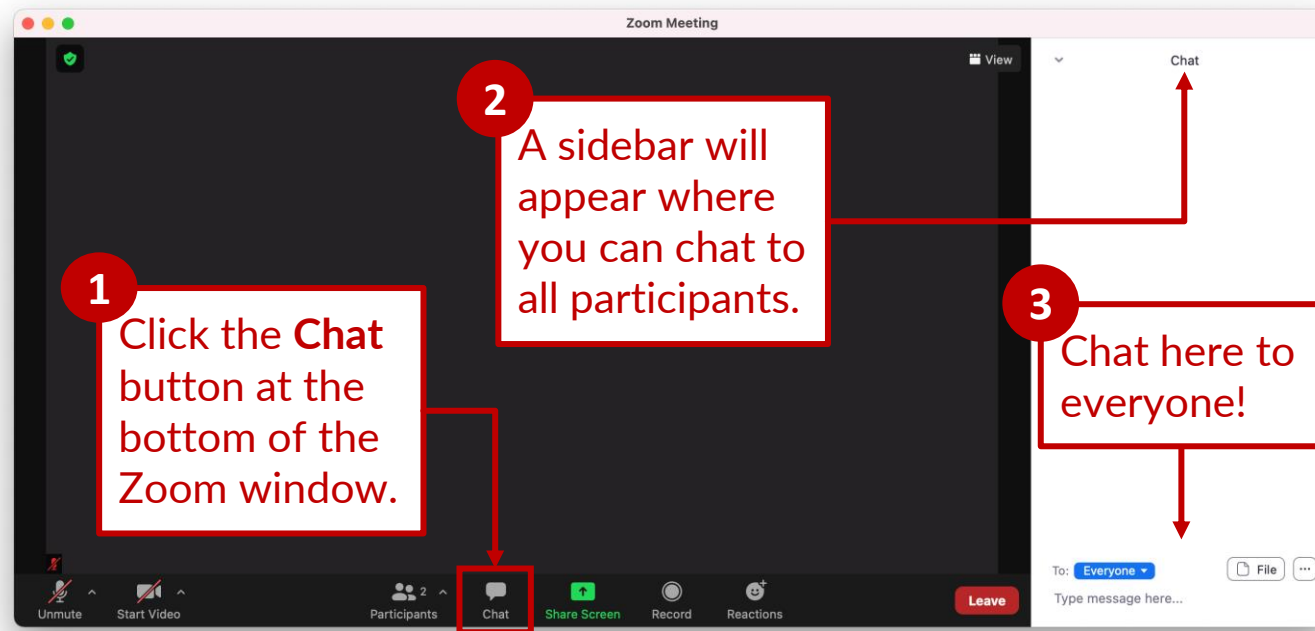

Overarching Goals

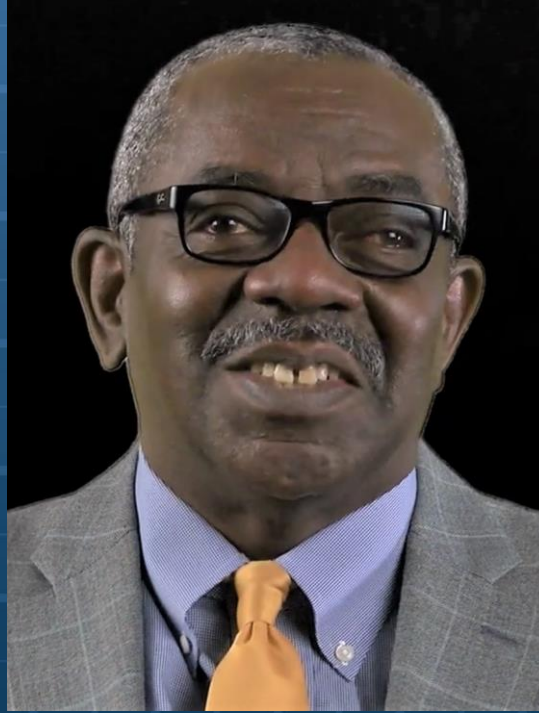
- To build the capacity of the staff to execute fatherhood services and support within the Healthy Start program for every grant year cycle

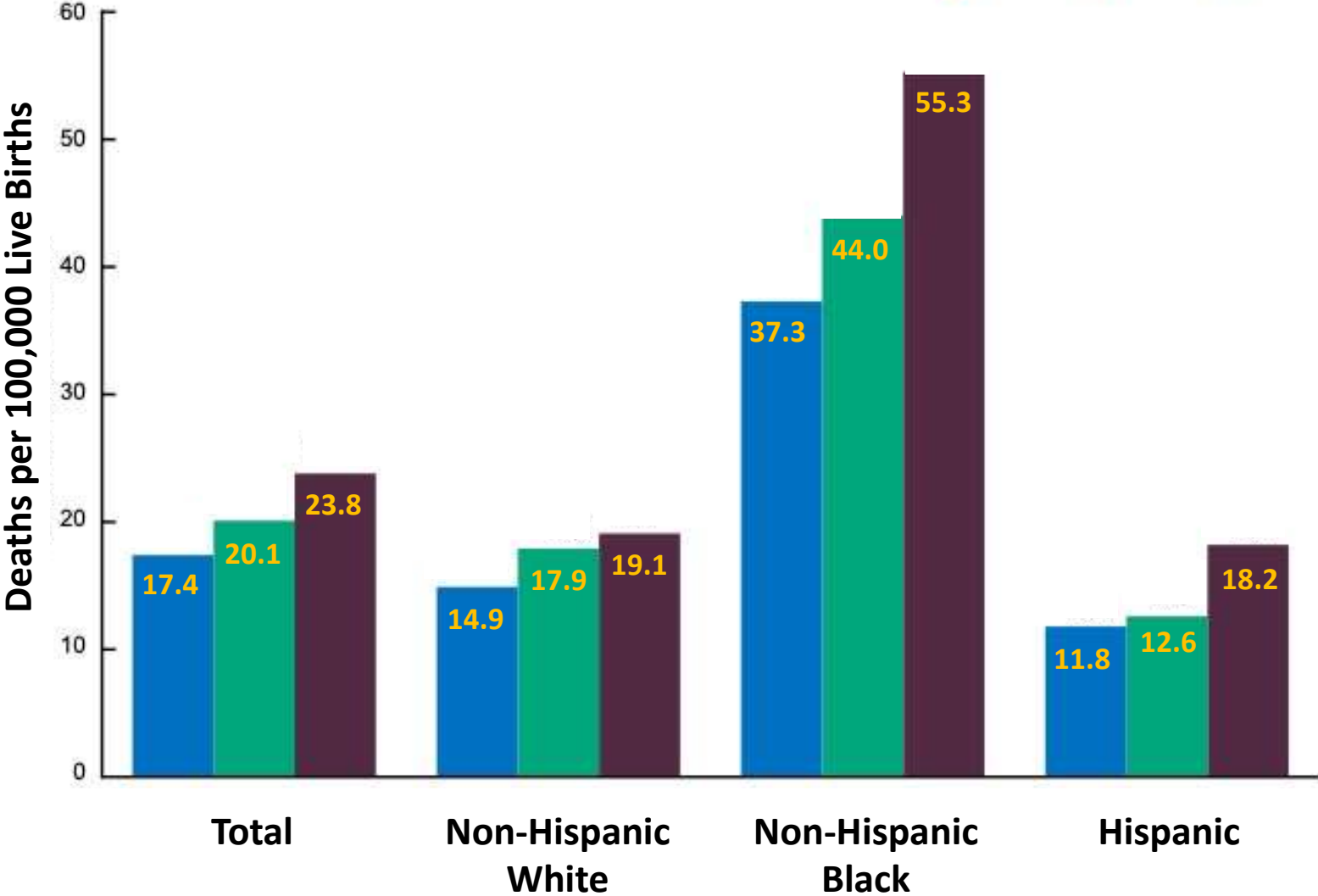

The rate for non-Hispanic Black women in 2020 was **2.9 times** the rate for non-Hispanic White women.

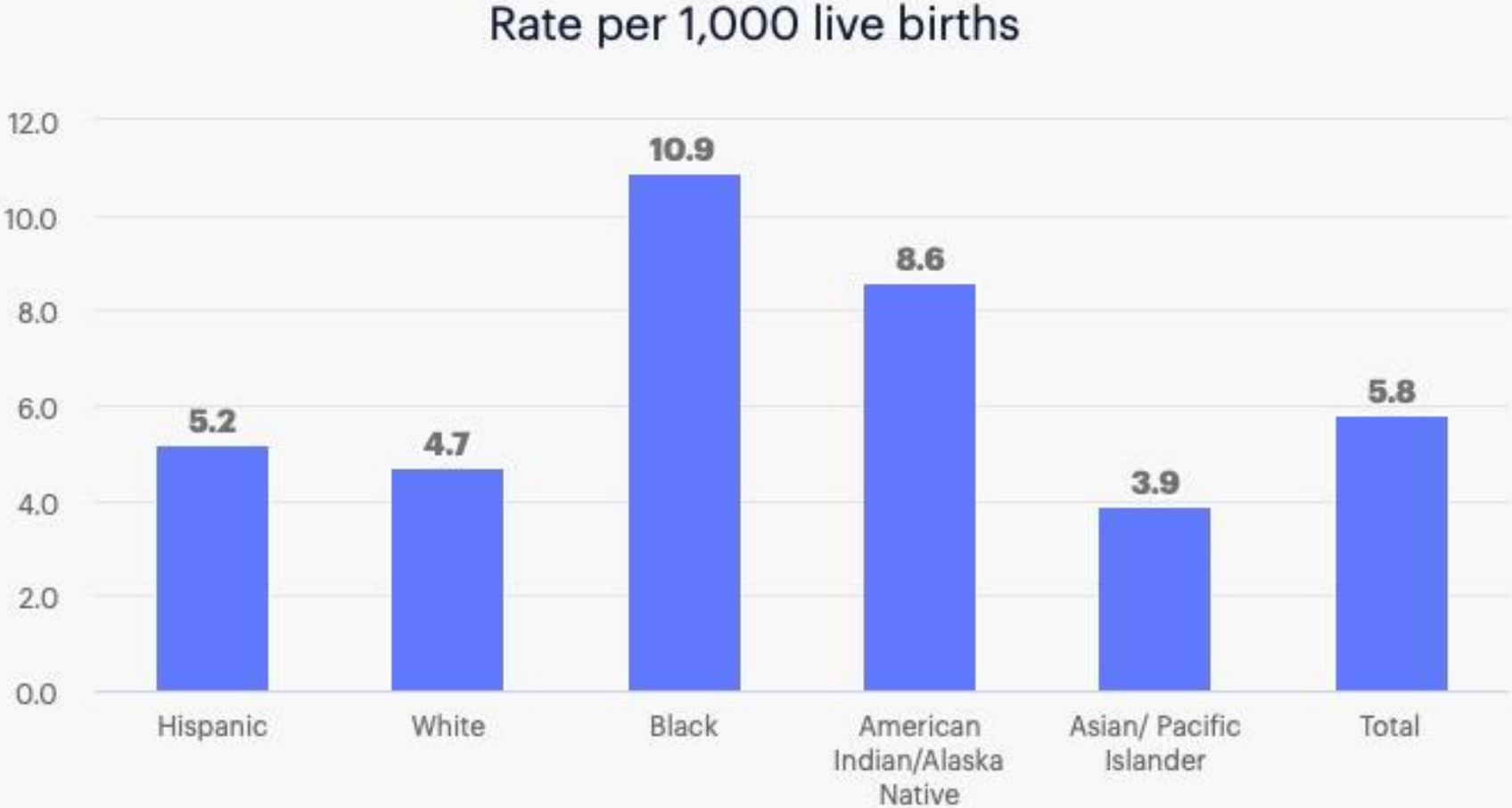

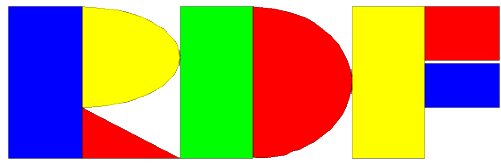
