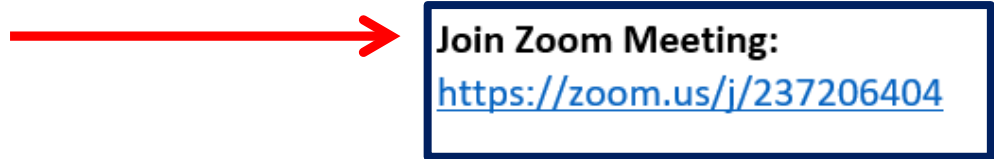

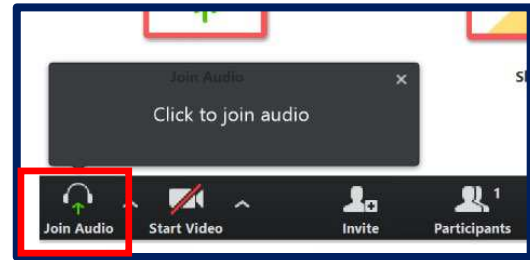
Connecting to the Audio Conference



- Join Zoom Meeting by **clicking Zoom Meeting link** & launching the Zoom application



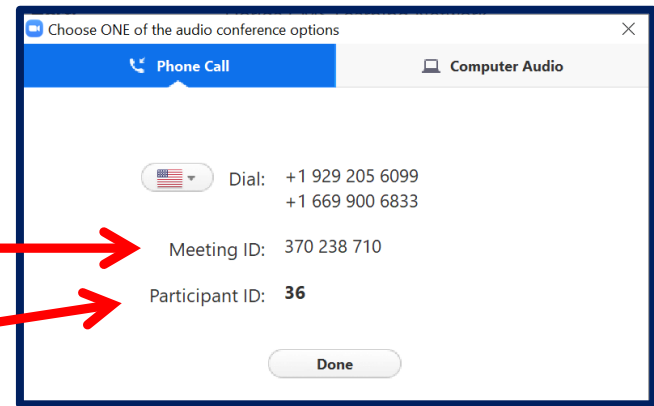
- An audio conference box will appear

Participating in a COIN

- An opportunity to join a team of self-motivated people with a collective vision, enabled by the web to collaborate in achieving a common goal by sharing ideas, information and work
- COIN participants will:
 1. Create and sustain a “cyberteam”
 2. Foster innovation through immediate and ongoing communication across all levels
 3. Ensure work is done in patterns characterized by meritocracy, transparency and openness to contributions from everyone
 4. Create innovations that are open and disruptive

Healthy Start COIN Time Commitment



- One-hour meeting on a monthly basis
 - Once COIN team is selected, the group will be polled to determine a regular day and time
- One hour of monthly CoLab engagement:
 - Engaging with fellow COIN team members and subject matter experts

- Thoughtfulness of application responses

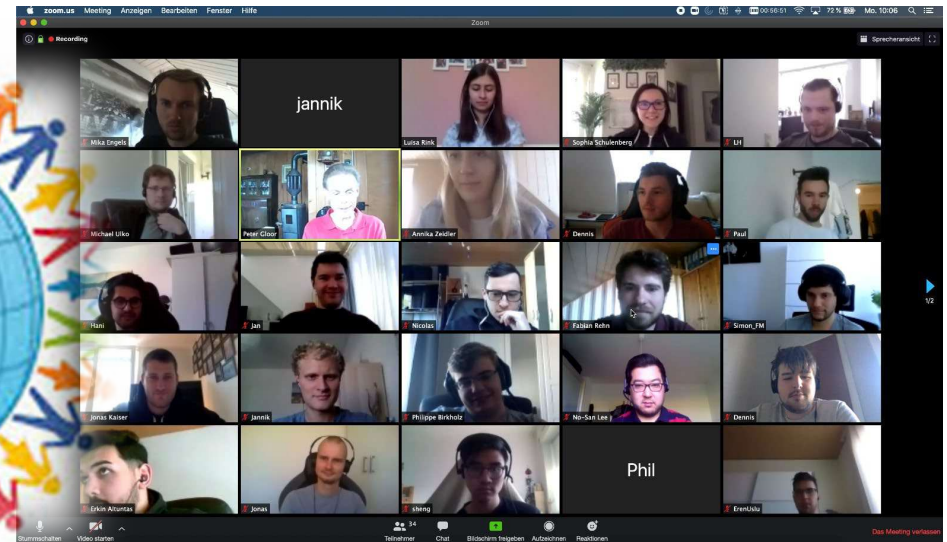

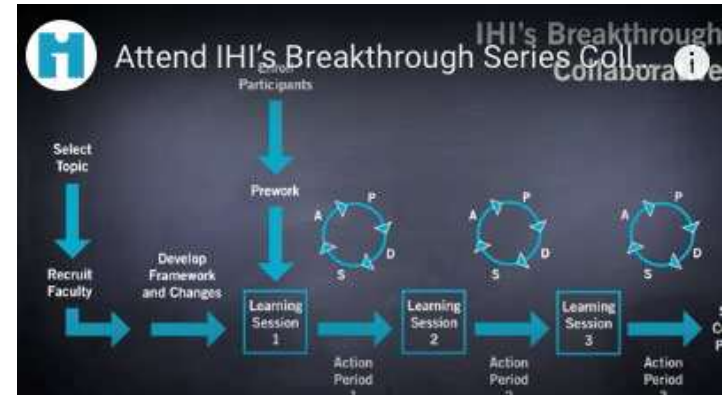




CoIN and COIN

CoIN – Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Network

- Goal: learning from others' experience
- Improve process through knowledge exchange
- IHI Breakthrough series (Plan/Do/Study/Act)
- Corresponds to “Collaborative Learning Network” in COIN framework



COIN – Collaborative Innovation Network

- Goal: Disruptive Innovation
- Intrinsically motivated team of 3 to 15, collaborating over the Web, to build something radically new (Swarmcreativity)
- Creator/COIN/CLN/CIN

Crazy Idea: “Hole in the wall”

- Minimally Invasive Education
- Sugata Mitra
- First tested in slums in India in 1999
- Using computers and the Internet
- children organize themselves into small groups. Each child is both student (learns from others) and teacher (teaches children who have less knowledge than him/her).

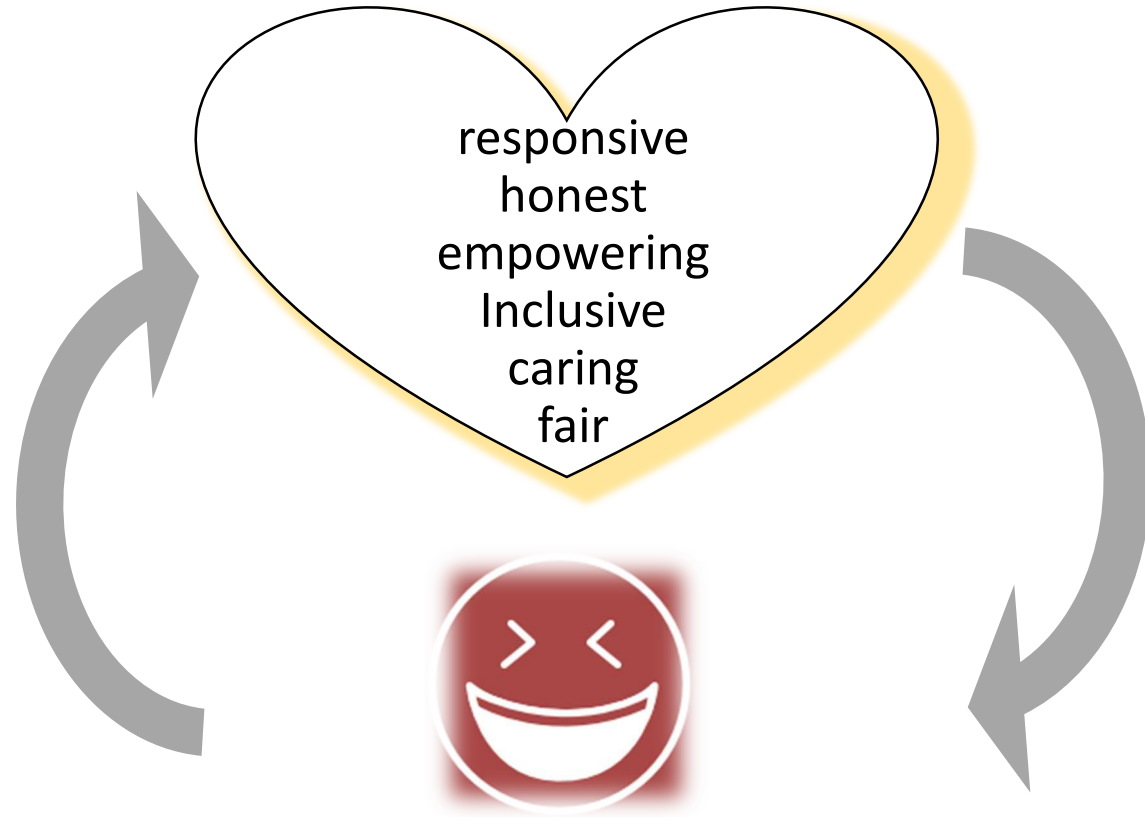




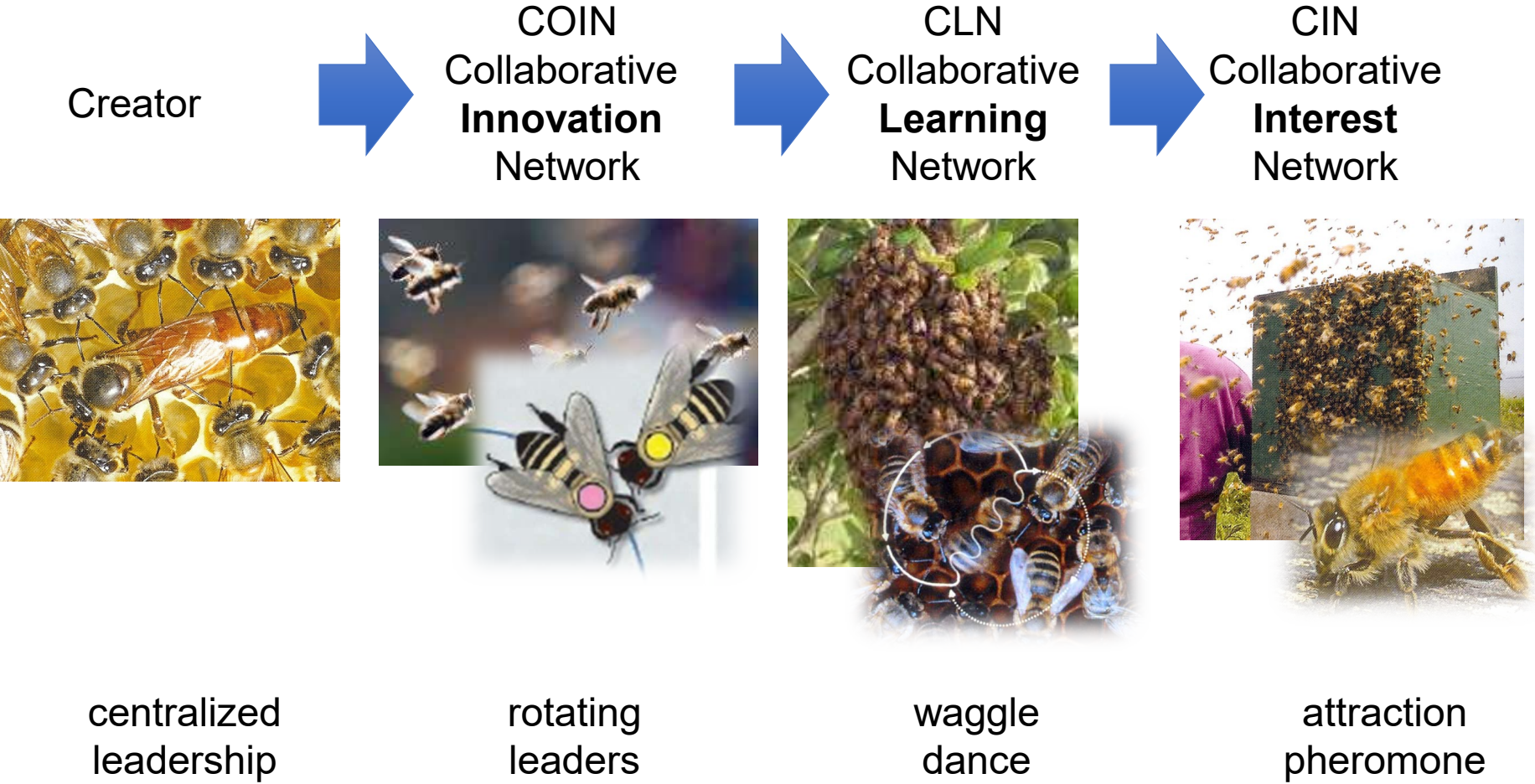
7 Honest Signals of Collaboration



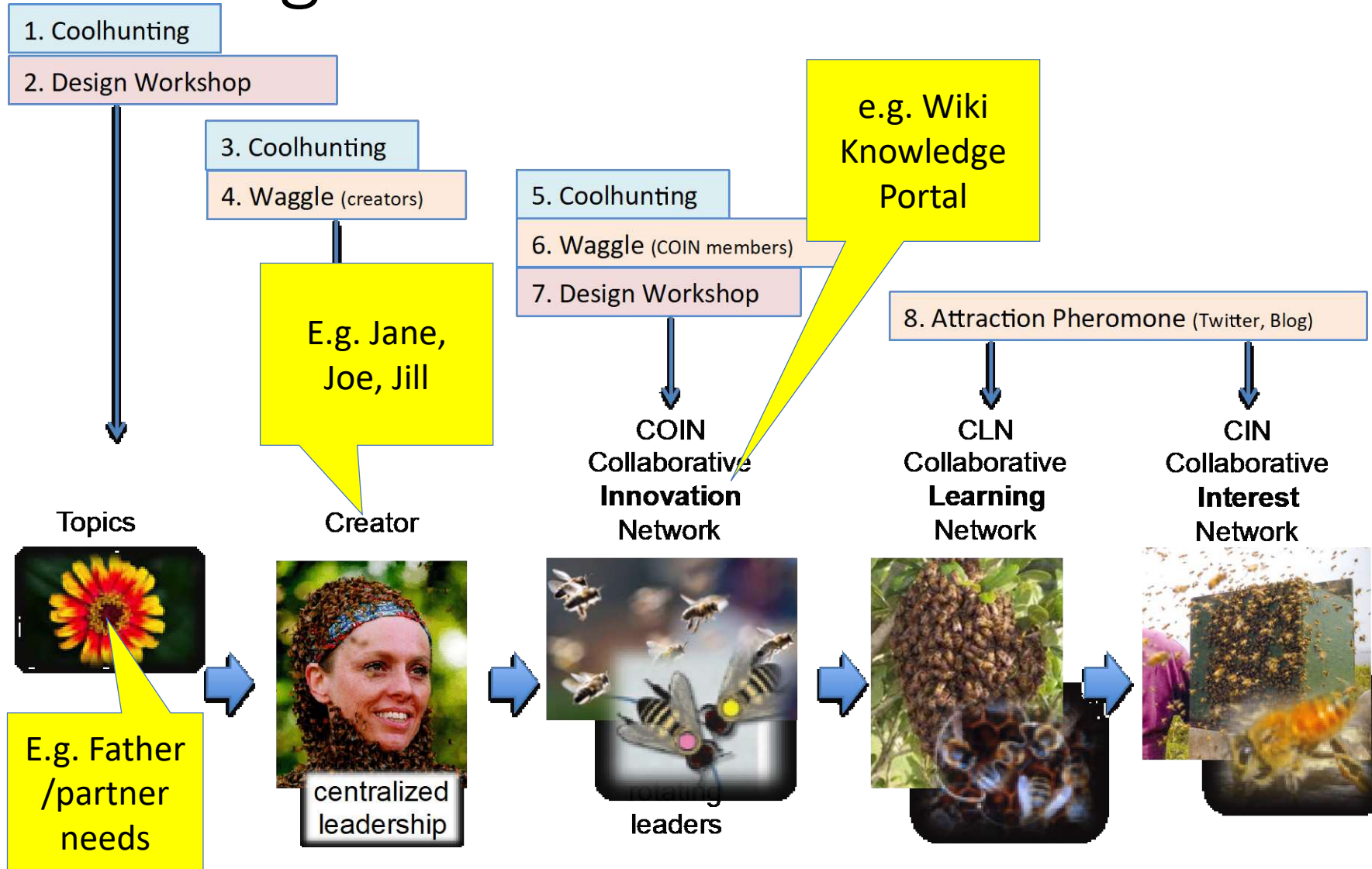

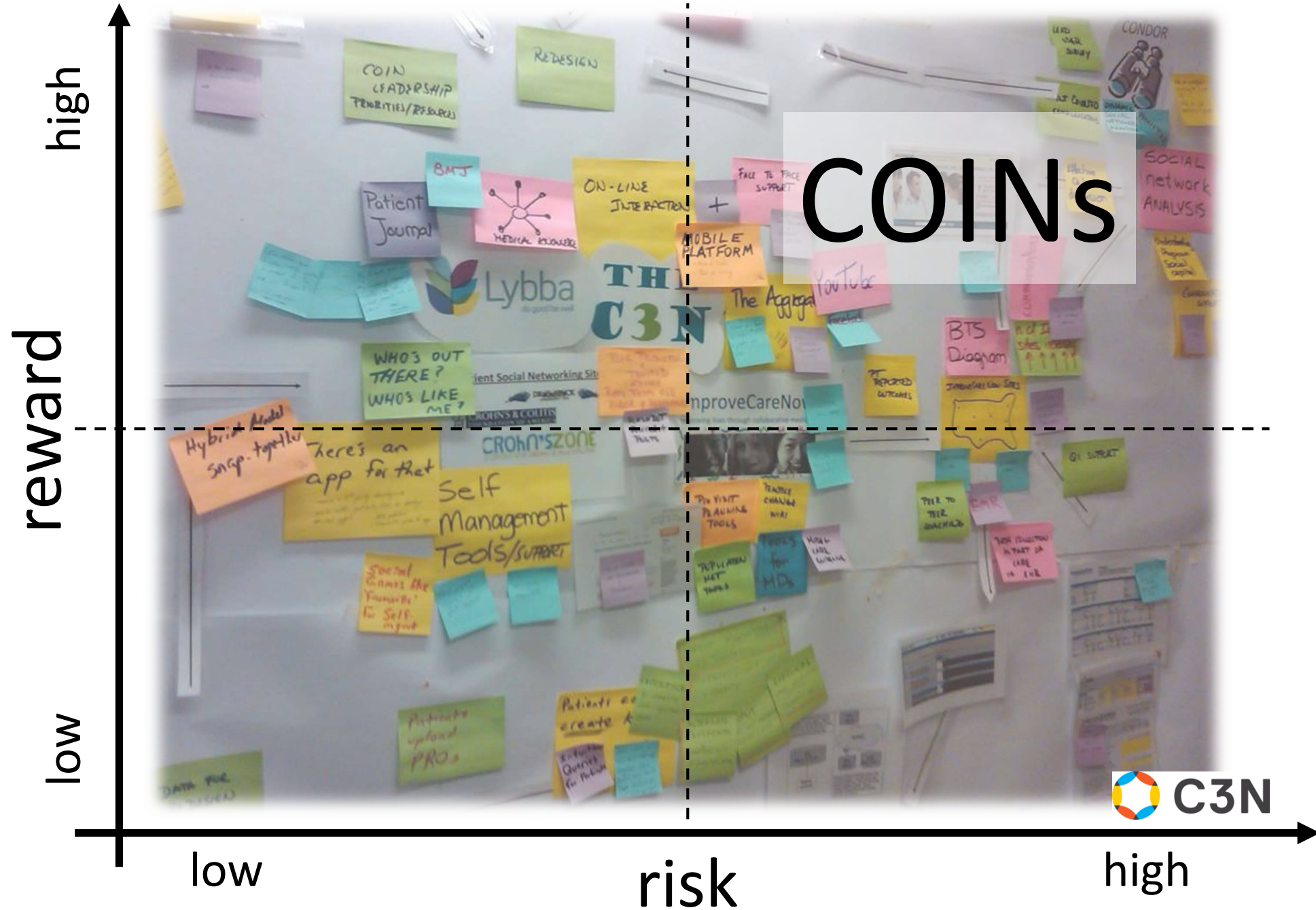


4 steps of COIN Creation



Coolfarming a new COIN



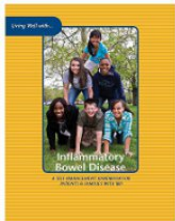

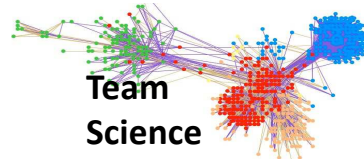

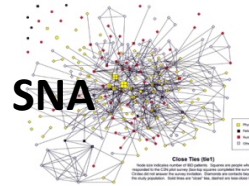
