What is the MATCHS Mentoring Program?

Mentoring Assistance & Technical Coaching for Healthy Start (MATCHS) Mentoring Program:

- Provides **peer-to-peer learning** and mentoring support to HS and HSE Project Directors
- Aims to strengthen **organizational leadership** and **program performance**

Who Should Participate?

Mentor Candidates

- Project Directors who work with an established HS program (at least one full five-year grant cycle)
- Those who have not experienced a change in management/leadership in the last two years
- Tenure as a Project Director (at least four years)
- Willing to commit to building a relationship with a newer PD

Mentee Candidates

- Newly appointed Project Director (less than three years in the role)
- Newly funded HS program (2024-2029 grant cycle is the first HS funding award)
- Willing to commit to building a relationship with a seasoned PD

Mentor/Mentee Pairs

Pairs will be assigned intentionally based on:

- Grantee demographics (i.e., urban, rural, etc.)
- Grantee type (i.e., HS, HSE)
- Organizational type (i.e., FQHC, health department, etc.)
- Population served
- Focus area

What to Expect:

Six-month commitment

2-3 hours per month

- Orientation Webinar
- Monthly mentor/mentee meetings & brief reports
 - Optional drop-in sessions
- Closed mentor/mentee group on the HS Hub
- Tools & Resources, including The Mentoring Manual for mentors & Full Focus planner for mentees
 - Mentors will receive \$2,000
